

# 8-IN-10 KANSANS AGREE.

A recent statewide survey showed that 78% - or nearly 8 out of every 10 - Kansans supports expanding the state's Medicaid program, KanCare.

## WHY SHOULD KANSAS EXPAND OUR MEDICAID PROGRAM, KANCARE?



### Health care costs are rising.

Expansion will help Kansans who currently have no options for coverage and keep costs down for the rest of us.



### Current KanCare limits are too low.

A single parent with two dependent children must make less than \$8,700 to qualify for KanCare.



### Expansion protects against medical debt.

Four out of every ten Kansans has medical debt or knows someone who does.



### Kansas is being left behind.

All of our surrounding states have expanded their Medicaid programs, leaving Kansas as one of only 12 states that haven't.



### Kansans want a long-term solution.

Families should be able to count on affordable health coverage when they need it most.



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
